the Town Hall and the Memorial Service at St. Edward's Church. She paid tribute at Full Council on 22nd September and queued to pay her respects at The Queen's Lying-in-State in Westminster Hall. Judith said: "We acknowledge The Queen's devotion and loyalty to Great Britain and the Commonwealth. We can never repay nor thank her enough for her 70 years of selfless service to all her people."



BRENTWOOD ROAD LOLLIPOP MAN/LADY

We are most concerned to hear from parents about the continuing dangers and near misses on the zebra crossing on Brentwood Road, which leads across to the junction with Globe Road. This crossing is used on a regular basis by the children and families of Hylands

Primary School and The Frances Bardsley Academy for Girls. We want to lobby Havering Council to employ a lollipop man or lady on this crossing. BRIDGE CLOSE PLANNING APPLICATION Cllr. Judith Holt has helped with some smaller applications in Malvern Road and Craigdale Road. Of particular concern is the future of the Havering Islamic Cultural Centre in Bridge Close. 
