CROW LANE

Residents in the middle section of Crow Lane should have received a letter and questionnaire from the Council regarding pedestrian crossings and no waiting/loading zones to help combat some of the parking and road safety issues that are occurring, particularly with HGV vehicles. Your councillors asked for this to gauge local opinion, so please respond.



RUSH GREEN ROAD

Last month, local residents alerted us to an unlawful vehicle spares and repairs yard, operating from a residential address in Rush Green Road, which was causing noise and nuisance. Since our intervention, Havering's Planning Enforcement Teams have issued the operators with a Temporary Stop Notice (TSN), and a Planning Contravention Notice (PCN).

GALLOWS CORNER

Sadiq Khan said that he would make Gallows Corner a priority. However over 6 years on, residents of Romford are still waiting for the investment to improve one of London's most dangerous junctions. Instead tacking the problem seriously, TfL have reduced the speed limit and added speed cameras, as a cheap fix! Anyone traveling during rush hour will know that these measures have done diddly squat to make this junction safer.
