Following Network Rail's decision to cull 600 trees on both sides of the the Romford to Upminster "push and pull" railway line, Aaron and Judith wrote directly to the Senior Public Affairs

Manager and a site meeting was held with Network Rail at the Heath Park Road bridge organised by Andrew Rosindell M.P. As a result, Network Rail agreed to cull only 40 trees. This great result shows what can happen when neighbours and local residents work together!
