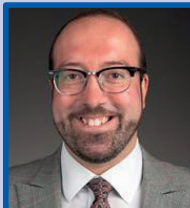

Park Security

Jason, Dilip and Carol continue to receive messages from residents concerned that the gates at Lawns Park and King George Playing Fields are still left unlocked overnight.

We wish to assure residents that we have explored every possible way to resolve this with the current HRA Administration, but the consistent response has been that there is no funding available.

This is despite the fact that at the Council's budget-setting meeting Dilip proposed a fully costed plan to commit new funding to boost park security. Unfortunately, all Havering Resident Association councillors chose to vote against our proposal.

Recognising the importance of this issue, Dilip, Jason and Carol remain undeterred. We will persist in raising this issue at the Town Hall until it is properly addressed.



Planning Enforcement

We have seen a rise in unapproved developments springing up (or out). Successful interventions have been secured against such activity in Hainault Road, Birch Close and around Collier Row. Please do contact us if you have concerns about development activity near you.



Weeds and Verges

Cllr. Carol Smith is pleased to report on the prompt start to the cutting of the grass verges in Collier Row this year and the beginning of the bi-annual weed spraying programme. These works should be complete by mid-May.



Dumped Rubbish

This remains the number one issue of concern for many Collier Row and Mawneys residents. Whilst we do our best to try to keep on top of this issue (through the proactive touring of the area), we need as many residents as possible keeping their eyes peeled for incidents of this nature so that we can report them to the Council for action.
