# 25 Years of service and action for Romford!

In May this year, Andrew Rosindell will have reached his twenty-fifth anniversary since his election to public office, representing the people of Romford.

He was first elected as a local councillor for the former Chase Cross Ward on 3rd May 1990, where he was the only Conservative to win a seat on Havering Council from the Liberal Democrats.

Cllr. Andrew Rosindell served the people of Collier Row, Chase Cross and Havering-atte-Bower in the Town Hall for twelve years, only leaving the Council in 2002 to focus on his new role as our M.P.

The year before, on 7th June 2001, Andrew had been elected the M.P. for Romford, winning the seat from Labour with the largest swing to the Conservatives in the entire U.K.!

Over that time, he has always been a strong voice for Romford, speaking up for local people, for our town and for the surrounding communities of Collier Row, Havering-atte-Bower, Gidea Park, Rush Green and Hornchurch.
